

## Exhibit 2 - Proposed land use types

1. “Cropland”
  - a. Cleared land used or available for agricultural use
  - b. Must contain hydric soils
2. “Forested land”
  - a. Land dominated by trees
  - b. Must contain hydric soils

### Additional considerations:

- Size Requirements: The site must be above 10 acres in size.
- Hydrology Restoration: The soil and topography must be capable of successfully and cost-effectively retaining water to return to a native wetland state.
- Clear Title & Access: The landowner must provide unencumbered legal right-of-way access to the proposed easement boundaries
