## **COMPETITIVE COMBINED SYNOPSIS/SOLICITATION**

### **INTRODUCTION**

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with FAR Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested, and a separate written solicitation will not be issued.

The solicitation number is 75N98026Q00606. This solicitation is issued as a competitive combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial products or commercial services. The Government intends to award a contract or purchase order resulting from this solicitation using full and open competition.

This acquisition is conducted under the authority of FAR 12.603, Streamlined Solicitation for Commercial Products or Commercial Services, and is not expected to exceed the simplified acquisition threshold.

### **NORTH AMERICAN INDUSTRY CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM (NAICS) CODE**

The intended procurement is classified under NAICS code 334516 with a Size Standard of 1000.

### **REGULATORY AUTHORITY**

The resultant contract will include all applicable provisions and clauses in effect through the Federal Acquisition Circular (FAC) 2026-01 effective March 13, 2026.

## **DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENT**

The Section on Behavioral Neuroscience at the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) is focusing on investigations of brain circuits and systems that require detailed analyses of neuronal circuit dynamics in freely moving animals with neurotransmitter specificity. Fiber photometry is a neuronal imaging technique used to monitor neuronal activity of specifically targeted cell populations. Fiber photometry uses excitation light from implanted fiber optics to record fluorescent activity of genetically encoded calcium or neurotransmitter-specific indicators in neuronal populations that fluoresce in the presence of calcium ions or neurotransmitter molecules. This imaging can be used at the same time that behavioral or electrophysiology experiments are being conducted giving a better understanding of the underpinning of brain function and its role in animal behavior in freely moving animals.

Projects being pursued by multiple members of the Section on Behavioral Neuroscience (SBN) require the acquisition of a ready to use wireless fiber photometry (FP) systems to measure the neural activity via calcium and neurotransmitter-specific sensors for work with non-human primates.

The wireless fiber photometry (FP) systems must meet the following salient characteristics:

This wireless fiber photometry system is small in size and has a wireless signal transmission distance that is 2 m in standard configuration and up to 5 m with an additional antenna.

-The new commercialized wireless fiber photometry system is the world's first, therefore it is currently the only one available on the market.

-The two new systems will complement two existing wired FP systems but allow neuronal data recording in experimental settings where animals are jumping and moving in the vertical direction, as non-human primates tend to do. In such conditions a wireless FP is needed to avoid large movement-related artifacts in the recorded data and to prevent damage of the FP equipment.

-The wireless transmission means that there are no cords that impede the animal's movement and introduce movement artifacts in the recorded signal.

-Can be used for both rats and marmosets in the lab and contains a small headstage good for mice, rats, marmosets, etc.
