

Industry should anticipate the majority of proposal requests will be small business set-asides (SBSA) but several may be full and open (unrestricted). Proposal requests are expected to be released in a phased approach as existing contract period of performance ends to ensure no gaps in support. Vendors are asked to indicate interest by completing the attached sources sought form and support declared capability (by MAPSS requirement) with a capability statement compliant with instructions provided. MDA will evaluate responses to this notification and use the information provided to frame the structure of capability areas and determine which portions of the MAPSS requirements will be solicited as SBSAs.

A summary of each requirement is provided by Tranche (below). Interested businesses must be capable of performing requirements for which they declare capability as the prime contractor, enterprise-wide, i.e., at all MDA locations noted in each requirement. Please note that the descriptions and details are examples of potential requirements and are provided for the purpose of assisting interested businesses to better understand these requirements. The resulting responses will assist MDA with defining the MAPSS initial acquisition strategy. These are not full work statements and may not represent the final requirements of any resultant request for proposal.

Participation is voluntary, but encouraged if your company is interested in competing for a future MAPSS requirements. This is initial market research to solicit Industry's feedback which will be used to form the basis of the overall MAPSS Acquisition Strategy. Market research will be refreshed in future years - by tranche - to ensure the Acquisition Strategy remains relevant. The final NAICS determination and contract vehicle for each requirement/capability area will depend on the group of work solicited at the time of proposal request.

Lastly, we recommend that the persons completing this survey be involved in the management and execution of these contracts as well as persons who will be involved in the development of proposals for MAPSS solicitations. Marketing materials and brochures are not requested and provide little value to this effort. The purpose of this RFI is to collect market research information to facilitate the development the overarching MAPSS Acquisition Strategy for Advisory and Assistance Support (A&AS) services. Data collected as part of this RFI as it pertains to Tranche #3 includes Public Affairs (PA) and the potential deconsolidation of TEAMS Next Facilities, Logistics & Environmental Management (FLE) into three (3) separate requirements for Environmental Management, Facilities (Space Management) and Logistics (FLE). Tranche #3 market research will be refreshed – approximately October 2026, January 2027, and March 2027 – to ensure the Acquisition Strategy remains relevant and is updated, if required.

Participation is voluntary, but encouraged if your company is interested in competing for a future MAPSS Tranche #3 contract.

Proprietary information is not sought by MDA.

There is no limit on the number of responses from any company; however responses

submitted should be targeted toward responding to the survey questions listed for the identified MAPSS Requirement/Contract of Interest selected. Some MAPSS requirements will have additional survey questions. Responses should include:

- 1) A completed 'Standard Form'. If additional information is needed to respond to these questions, it must be entered into the space provided on the second page of the PDF form.
- 2) A Capabilities Statement file. This file must contain *relevant* experience information and address any additional survey questions not on the 'Standard Form'. Contractor format is acceptable for this file but it must be a single stacked/combined file of the documents you wish to provide to demonstrate capability, not to exceed five (5) pages.
 - Note: Relevant experience includes projects/contracts that are similar to the described MAPSS requirement and that have occurred in the past 5 years. Please do not provide general capability statements.
 - The Capability Statement should contain at least one (1) relevant project to demonstrate capability and include the following information:
 1. Customer Name and Customer/Client POC Email
 2. Period of Performance and Total Contract Value

Tranche 3 – MAPSS Public Affairs

Aid the Missile Defense Agency (MDA) Directorate of Public Affairs (PA) by providing comprehensive and dedicated support services to the Agency's director, senior leadership, programs, and organizations. These services include, but are not limited to, daily and event-specific media compilations, communication products, flight test support, internet and intranet information support, security and policy review processes, and Agency processes. Activities required include support of flight test missions, internal and external publications and informational products, public release approval processes, multi-media support, records management, and Agency and PA standard operating procedures.

This requirement includes, but is not limited to, support for: maintenance and implementation of the MDA environmental management program including development of agency policies, procedures, and internal controls; development, application, and management of programs for environmental restoration, sustainability, conservation, permitting, and pollution prevention including sustainability issues, initiatives, and reporting requirements; and, ensuring National Environmental Policy Act and other environmental regulatory compliance.

Requirements include assisting with customer and end-user communications about space, services, and cost, as well as supporting the planning and programming for operational requirements to ensure facility availability; support corporate and regulatory compliance for facility operations and sustainment; support and assist in the oversight and management of all aspects of facility operations to create an optimal, safe and cost effective environment for the building occupants. Additionally, support requirements include, but are not limited to, development and planning, and oversight of the facility systems maintenance, development of project scopes, designs, planning documents, and oversight for repair and alteration projects of real property including minor construction; support the development and coordination of the facility assessment program in support of facilities life-cycle management including sustainment and disposal; building operations planning, coordination, and oversight; move coordination and space management; interior design support including National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), Unified Facility Criteria (UFC), and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance.
