



Industry should anticipate the majority of proposal requests will be small business set-asides (SBSA) but several may be full and open (unrestricted). Proposal requests are expected to be released in a phased approach as existing contract period of performance ends to ensure no gaps in support. Vendors are asked to indicate interest by completing the attached sources sought form and support declared capability (by MAPSS requirement) with a capability statement compliant with instructions provided. MDA will evaluate responses to this notification and use the information provided to frame the structure of capability areas and determine which portions of the MAPSS requirements will be solicited as SBSAs.

A summary of each requirement is provided by Tranche (below). Interested businesses must be capable of performing requirements for which they declare capability as the prime contractor, enterprise-wide, i.e., at all MDA locations noted in each requirement. Please note that the descriptions and details are examples of potential requirements and are provided for the purpose of assisting interested businesses to better understand these requirements. The resulting responses will assist MDA with defining the MAPSS initial acquisition strategy. These are not full work statements and may not represent the final requirements of any resultant request for proposal.

Participation is voluntary, but encouraged if your company is interested in competing for a future MAPSS requirements. This is initial market research to solicit Industry's feedback which will be used to form the basis of the overall MAPSS Acquisition Strategy. Market research will be refreshed in future years - by tranche - to ensure the Acquisition Strategy remains relevant. The final NAICS determination and contract vehicle for each requirement/capability area will depend on the group of work solicited at the time of proposal request.

Lastly, we recommend that the persons completing this survey be involved in the management and execution of these contracts as well as persons who will be involved in the development of proposals for MAPSS solicitations. Marketing materials and brochures are not requested and provide little value to this effort. The purpose of this RFI is to collect market research information to facilitate the development the overarching MAPSS Acquisition Strategy for Advisory and Assistance Support (A&AS) services. Data collected as part of this RFI as it pertains to Tranche #4 includes the potential deconsolidation of TEAMS Next Program Planning and Acquisition (PP&A) into two (2) separate requirements for Acquisition & Program Planning and International Affairs; the potential deconsolidation of TEAMS Next Agency Operations into two (2) separate requirements for Business Operations and Human Resources & Training; and Warfighter Integration. Tranche #4 market research will be refreshed – approximately December 2027/January 2028 – to ensure the Acquisition Strategy remains relevant and is updated, if required.

Participation is voluntary, but encouraged if your company is interested in competing for a future MAPSS Tranche #4 contract.

Proprietary information is not sought by MDA.

There is no limit on the number of responses from any company; however responses submitted should be targeted toward responding to the survey questions listed for the identified

MAPSS Requirement/Contract of Interest selected. Some MAPSS requirements will have additional survey questions. Responses should include:

- 1) A completed 'Standard Form'. If additional information is needed to respond to these questions, it must be entered into the space provided on the second page of the PDF form.
- 2) A Capabilities Statement file. This file must contain *relevant* experience information and address any additional survey questions not on the 'Standard Form'. Contractor format is acceptable for this file but it must be a single stacked/combined file of the documents you wish to provide to demonstrate capability, not to exceed five (5) pages.
  - Note: Relevant experience includes projects/contracts that are similar to the described MAPSS requirement and that have occurred in the past 5 years. Please do not provide general capability statements.

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- The Capability Statement should contain at least one (1) relevant project to demonstrate capability and include the following information:
  1. Customer Name and Customer/Client POC Email
  2. Period of Performance and Total Contract Value
  3. Description of Product and/or Services Provided; available Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) Data, if applicable

### **Tranche 4 – MAPSS Acquisition & Program Planning**

Aid the Missile Defense Agency (MDA) by performing acquisition management in accordance with the MDA's acquisition framework & lifecycle and providing support for acquisition assessment, oversight, documentation and assistance throughout MDA to Missile Defense System (MDS) development through all phases of the acquisition life cycle, analysis, assessments and decision tools supporting MDS baselines. This requirement also serves as the executing agent for MDS programmatic integration and synchronization across the three baselines (Resource, Schedule and Performance) and the MDA Change Management Process, performing integration and synchronization analyses; providing MDS Increment Champions analyses of increment status and health; and providing Schedule Baseline integration management on behalf of the Schedule Baseline Functional Manager. Responsible for developing and issuing Earned Value Management (EVM) and Integrated Baseline Review policies for the Agency -- assess cost and schedule performance, execute integrated baseline reviews, and provide recommendations to the Agency for tailored contract reporting or EVM deviations. Key products include acquisition strategies, acquisition plans, contract requirements packages, industry engagement, source selection plans, contract opportunity and fee documents, baseline management, data and property acquisition management.

Aid the Missile Defense Agency (MDA) by leading the Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution process and product for the agency; providing corporate-level assessments to define and examine alternative resourcing strategies covering changing conditions and trends, threats, technologies, and economic assessments; implementing and maintaining an infrastructure providing Agency and program office management with real-time financial information necessary for sound decision making on MDA programs. Additionally, this requirement includes developing, documenting, and delivering high quality cost estimates to justify, acquire, and sustain financial resources to effectively and efficiently accomplish the MDA Director's strategic goal of optimizing available resources. Responsible for maintaining the accuracy and timeliness of MDA accounting records, reports and processes; supporting MDA's resource management processes and products by overseeing and managing MDA's business systems and tools, identifying opportunities for further automation and continual improvement of business processes; overseeing and managing MDA's Implementing Agency and Work for Others Administrative Trust Fund and FMS Case Funded requirements and activities; and, providing financial guidance, fiscal oversight, policy, accounting, audit, financial systems and management of resources for FMS programs while being good stewards of Foreign Partner funds.

Aid the Missile Defense Agency (MDA) Warfighter Operational Integration Directorate (DW) by providing support to conduct strategic and operational level interface with Warfighter stakeholders including Combatant Commanders, Joint Staff, Joint Functional Component Command for Integrated Missile Defense, and the Service Departments to manage operational and sustainment activities with the purpose of assuring sustained mission readiness of the fielded system; continued development and fielding of future missile defense capabilities and assist with Doctrine, Organization, Training, Materiel, Leadership and Education, Personnel, Facilities, and Policy (DOTMLPF-P) activities.
