



Vehicle Access Points

- Ⓐ Critical Emergency Vehicle Access Point. Must remain open to large vehicle access 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Any disruption to vehicle access route will require immediate mitigation.
- Ⓑ Important Operational Vehicle Access Point. Contractor to provide minimum 2 week notice prior to any activities disrupting access or vehicle route. Alternate access provisions by contractor may be required
- Ⓒ Major Traffic Access Way. Contractor to provide minimum 3 week notice prior to any activity disrupting access. A traffic control plan & encroachment permits are required.

Pedestrian Access Points

- ① Major public & staff entry point. Contractor to provide minimum 3 week notice prior to any construction activities disrupting access. An Accessible Alternate Pedestrian Access Plan will be required.
- ② Secure Staff entry point. Contractor to provide minimum 2 week notice prior to any activities disrupting access. An Accessible Alternate Pedestrian Access Plan may be required.
- ③ Possible egress point. Contractor to provide minimum 2 week notice prior to any activities disrupting egress. An alternate exit plan with fire marshal approval may be required.
