8	For a contract for goods and services, other than goods and services related to telecommunications and information services, building construction and maintenance, or instructional materials, whether the vendor or the vendor's ultimate parent company or majority owner; (A) Has its principal place of business in the State of Texas; or (B) Employs at least 500 persons in the State of Texas	2
9	Environmentally Sensitive	2
10	Delivery Requirements	7
11	District Community Involvement	3
12	Company or local representative involved in litigation against a school district	6
13	Other relevant factors specifically listed in the solicitation	10
